

# Measurement – 1.9

Make a straight line from each dot as directed.

The grid contains the following measurement tasks:

- 10 centimeters: A dot at (1, 9) with an arrow pointing right.
- 1 centimeter: A dot at (1, 8) with an arrow pointing right.
- 12 centimeters: A dot at (3, 8) with an arrow pointing right.
- 16 centimeters: A dot at (10, 7) with an arrow pointing left.
- 7 centimeters: A dot at (1, 6) with an arrow pointing right.
- 6 centimeters: A dot at (6, 6) with an arrow pointing right.
- 11 centimeters: A dot at (7, 5) with an arrow pointing left.
- 9 centimeters: A dot at (1, 4) with an arrow pointing down.
- 9 centimeters: A dot at (3, 4) with an arrow pointing down.
- 8 centimeters: A dot at (9, 4) with an arrow pointing left.
- 7 centimeters: A dot at (9, 3) with an arrow pointing down.
- 2 centimeters: A dot at (4, 1) with an arrow pointing up.
- 3 centimeters: A dot at (5, 1) with an arrow pointing up.
- 4 centimeters: A dot at (6, 1) with an arrow pointing up.
- 5 centimeters: A dot at (7, 1) with an arrow pointing up.
- 6 centimeters: A dot at (8, 1) with an arrow pointing up.
