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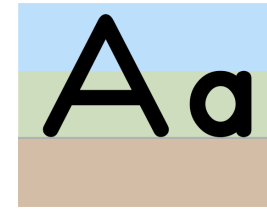

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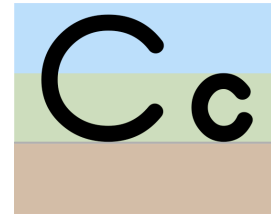

Only 100 words account for half of the words that we ever speak or write! At the same time, many of them are easily misspelled – so a list like this can be handy.

## for / four

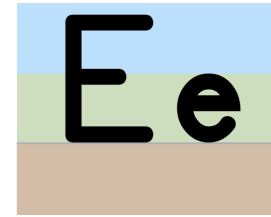
